Qualifications and Students

At a glance:

- The 2021 Census asked people about their qualifications and whether they had completed an apprenticeship
- 24% of the District's residents aged 16+ have no qualifications
- 5.4% have completed an apprenticeship
- 27.4% have a Level 4 or higher qualification equivalent to a degree
- 2.9% have other qualifications (including world-wide qualifications)
- 24.4% of the District's residents aged 5+ are students

Highest level of qualification

24% of Bradford residents aged 16 and over had no qualifications – this is the second lowest percentage in West Yorkshire, after Wakefield. Bradford also has lower rates than the regional and national averages. This is lower than the 2011 figure of 27.7%.

13.6% of the District's 16+ residents have Level 2 qualifications (lower than the 2011 figure of 14.8%) this is the equivalent to achieving GCSE grades 9 - 4 or previously graded from A* - C.

27.4% have a Level 4 or above qualification (equivalent to a degree) – higher than the 2011 figure of 21.8%, but lower than the regional and national averages.

Students

The census asked respondents whether they were students. 24.4% of the Bradford population aged 5 and over are students. This is the highest percentage in West Yorkshire and is higher than the regional and national averages.
