At a glance

- 18.1% of people in Shipley are under-16
- 6.7% are Asian/Asian British and 5.4% are Muslim
- 13.9% of children are living in poverty and 5% of LSOAs are in the 10% most deprived in England
- House prices are lower than the national average
- Health and social work, retail and manufacturing are the top employment sectors
- 67.6% of the working age population are economically active and 64.5% are in employment
- 6.4% of people aged 18-24 are unemployed
- Earnings of people living in Shipley are lower than the national average


