- 19.6% of the population is under-16
- 16.8% is Asian/Asian British and 15.7% is Muslim
- 26.6% of children live in poverty and 23% of LSOAs are in the 10% most deprived in England
- House prices are lower than the national average
- Health and social work, retail and manufacturing are the top employers
- 76.7% of the working age population is economically active and 72.4% are in employment
- 7.4% of people aged 18-24 are unemployed
- Earnings of people living in Keighley are lower than the national average

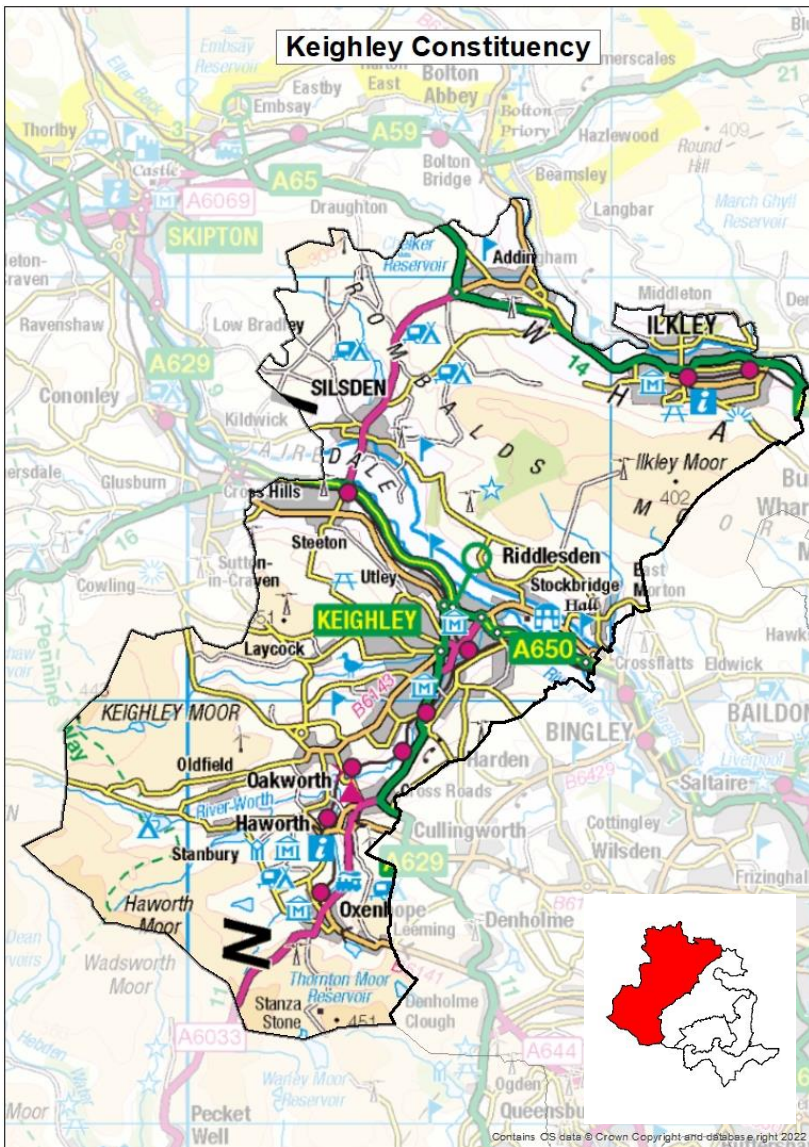
